## Sorting Basics

1) Paper – Newspaper, office paper, magazines, phone books.

2) Cardboard – cereal and tissue boxes up to regular corrugated cardboard

3) Plastic, Steel and Aluminum Cans – Rinsed and all bagged together.

- Plastic jugs, bottles-Must have recycle symbol – NO Styrofoam or packaging material
- Steel Cans – soup, vegetable, coffee cans – rinsed out
- Aluminum beverage cans.

### How do I do that you might wonder?

Put the provided plastic tote in a convenient place, office or where you open your mail. Use it for paper.

To get the most cardboard leave an empty cereal or soda box in kitchen, then flatten the other small boxes and put them in it.

For the plastic, steel and aluminum cans use a trashcan lined with blue or clear liner.

On recycle day put the small boxes on top of the paper, blue bag on top of that and place out by your garbage containers. If you have large boxes place them flattened underneath the green container.

**Important – Put this on the inside of a kitchen cabinet door for future reference!!!**
