Carroll moved to recess into Executive Session, until 9:10 p.m., for nonelected personnel issues. Seconded by Nations. Motion carried.


Carroll moved to return to the Regular Session. Seconded by Harris. Motion carried.

Nations moved to offer Richard Faulkner the position of Building Inspector/Zoning Administrator/Code Enforcement Officer position for 20 hours/week with attendance at meetings additional at a wage of \$18.50 per hour with a \$.50 per hour increase following a successful 6-month probationary period, shall work a defined three day per week schedule not to include Mondays with the exception of Planning Commission meetings that are currently held at 7:00 p.m. on the second and fourth Mondays of each month, a \$50/month mileage allowance without reimbursement for vehicle insurance, and this would be the final offer. Seconded by Carroll. Motion carried. Ward voted against.
