Section 17.60.010 Designated.

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 19 of Title 11 of the Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended, the city council of the city designates itself as the redevelopment agency (the "agency") for the city for the purpose of implementing the Utah Neighborhood Development Act, as amended (the "Act"). (Ord. no. 92 §1, 1982.)

Section 17.60.020 Powers generally. The agency shall be authorized to enter into contracts generally and shall have all powers necessary to transact the business and to exercise all the powers provided for in the Act. (Ord. no. 92 §2, 1982.)

Section 17.60.030 Authority to accept financial and other

assistance.

The agency shall have the right and power to accept financial and other assistance from any public or private source for the agency's activities, powers, and duties, and to expend any funds so received for any of the purposes authorized under the Act. (Ord. no. 92 §3, 1982.)

Section 17.60.040 Authority to accept governmental aid.

The agency may borrow money or accept financial or other assistance from the state or the

federal government for any redevelopment project within its area of operation and may comply with any conditions of such loan or grant. (Ord. no. 92 §4, 1982.)

Section 17.60.050 Cooperation with other agencies.

The agency shall be authorized to cooperate with similar agencies of other communities for joint planning and joint development of any particular project with may be authorized by ordinances pursuant to Section 11-19-4 of the Act. (Ord. no. 92 §5, 1982.)

Section 17.60.060 Employment of staff--Compensation.

The agency is authorized to employ an executive director, technical experts, consultants, and such other agents and employees, permanent and temporary, as it may require. The agency may also employ or retain its own legal counsel and legal staff. The agency is authorized to compensate the foregoing individuals from funds available to the agency. (Ord. no. 92 §6, 1982.)
