## LINDON COMMUNITY CENTER

Lindon City has completed the purchase of the Lindon Community Center!! The facility is located at 25 North Main Street in the building which was formerly an LDS Church building. The building has a long history in Lindon, and was built by the hands of Lindon residents, many of whom still live here, or have family living here!

The City was able to purchase the building from the LDS Church over a three year period as cash funds were available. This means the City has no debt associated with the Community Center. In addition, the City was awarded approximately \$200,000 in grant funding to start renovations to the Senior Citizens Center which will be housed at the Community Center. A generous private donation has also been made to enhance work on the Senior Citizens Center, which will serve many lifetime Lindon residents.

In addition to the building, all the furniture and fixtures, including pianos, the organ, sound system, tables and chairs, even dishes are now owned by the City. This presents great opportunities for cultural arts programs and a variety of events at the Community Center! Thanks to the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints for their generosity in allowing the City to continue to make this building a part of the Lindon community!

You are invited to visit the Community Center, tour the facilities, and give your input for programs you would like to see included! Please visit during Lindon Days on Saturday, August 14, 2010 from 11:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. There will also be a display of historic photographs and information about the building during the years it served as a church.
