## NOTICE PUBLIC HEARING& BONDS TO BE ISSUED

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Bonding Act, Title 11, Chapter 14, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, that on December 14, 2010, the City Council (the "Council") of Lindon City, Utah (the "Issuer"), adopted a resolution (the "Resolution") in which it authorized the issuance of the Issuer's Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series 2011 (the "Series 2011 Bonds") and the calling of a public hearing to receive input from the public with respect to (a) the issuance of the Series 2011 Bonds and (b) any potential economic impact that the Project described herein to be financed with the proceeds of the Series 2011 Bonds may have on the private sector.

### TIME, PLACE AND LOCATION OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Issuer shall hold a public hearing on January 18, 2011, at the hour of 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter, in the City Council Chambers at 100 North State Street, Lindon, Utah. The purpose of the hearing is to receive input from the public with respect to (a) the issuance of the Series 2011 Bonds and (b) any potential economic impact that the Project to be financed with the proceeds of the Series 2011 Bonds may have on the

private sector. All members of the public are invited to attend and participate.

### PURPOSE FOR ISSUING THE SERIES 2011 BONDS

The Series 2011 Bonds will be issued for the purpose of financing the construction, and installation of gravity lines, a pump station and other sewer related improvements (collectively, the "Project"), and paying costs of issuance of the Series 2011 Bonds. The project will increase the outflow line from an 18 inch pipe to a 24 inch pipe and increase capacity of the pump station to handle Lindon's build out population.

### PARAMETERS OF THE SERIES 2011 BONDS

The Issuer intends to issue not more than Four Million Five Hundred Six Thousand Dollars (\$4,560,000) of its Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series 2011 (the "Series 2011 Bonds"), to bear interest at a rate not to exceed 2.50% per annum on the unpaid principal balance, to mature in not more than twenty-five (25) years from their date or dates, and to be sold at a price not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the total principal amount thereof.

The Series 2011 Bonds are to be issued and sold by the Issuer pursuant to the Resolution, including as part of said Resolution, the draft of a Final Bond Resolution, which was before the Council and attached to the Resolution in substantially final form at the time of the adoption of the Resolution and said Final Bond Resolution, is to be adopted by the Council in such form and with such changes thereto as shall be approved by the Council; provided that the principal amount, interest rate, or rates, maturity, and discount of the Series 2011 Bonds will not exceed the maximums set forth above. A copy of the Resolution and the Final Bond Resolution are on file in the office of the City Recorder of Lindon City, 100 North State Street, Lindon, Utah, where they may be examined during regular business hours of the City Recorder from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, for a period of at least thirty (30) days from and after the date of publication of this notice.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that a period of thirty (30) days from and after the date of the publication of this notice is provided by law during which any person in interest shall have the right to contest the legality of the Resolution, the Final Bond Resolution, or the Series 2011 Bonds, or any provision made for the security and payment of the Series 2011 Bonds, and that after such time, no one shall have any cause of action to contest the regularity, formality, or legality thereof for any cause whatsoever.

USER CHARGE RATES AND CONNECTION FEES Rates for the base charge of a residential unit are estimated to increase 6% effective July 1, 2011 to help finance this project. The base rate per residential unit is currently \$11.31 and will be adjusted to \$11.99. Adjustments to connection fees are not anticipated at this time.
