NOTICE: WATER METER CHANGE OUT

Over the past year Lindon City has been working on a water meter change out program. This has consisted of changing out the old meters that we manually read five times during the year for the new meters that are on an automated meter reading system. These meters have new registers with wiring that goes up to the lids and connects to a sensor that sends a signal to a laptop computer which reports the gallons of water used each month. This change out allows city personnel to read all of the meters more frequently and in a much shorter time period. Accessing or tampering with city water meters is a Class B misdemeanor with penalties as provided in city code 13.040.080. If you need to shut off your water for any reason, use the shut off valve in your home. These shut off valves are located inside your home where the water line comes into your house. In some of the older homes you may not have a shut off valve and would need to contact Lindon City Public Works (801-796-7954) to assist you in shutting your water off. The water meters belong to Lindon City and only Lindon City personnel are allowed to open them. If we find that the meters and/or lids have been tampered with the homeowner/and or business owners will be responsible for all fines and repair costs.
