MURDOCK CANAL ENCLOSURE PROJECT UPDATE

Following is the latest information from Ames Construction Company who is responsible for the piping of the Murdock Canal. Please remember this information is subject to change depending on the construction schedule.

- 200 South Street will be completely closed on Tuesday, February 7, 2012 and will remain closed for 6-8 weeks.
- 1600 North Street in Orem will be reopened on Monday, February 6, 2012 to provide an outlet for much of the East bench.
- Pedestrian access will be allowed through 200 South during the closure, with a walkway on the north side of the bridge.
- Lindon Center Street piping and rough grading will be completed by February 20th, at the earliest.
