From the Desk of the Mayor May 2014

This month I am reflecting on the past year regarding the progress we have made since I took office in May of 2013. I will also be meeting with the Trustees and employees to reflect further. If any resident would like to meet with me, please give me a call or send me an email. The following are a list of the highlights over the last year.

- We approved the Developer agreement with Stever Miller for a 34 house subdivision at Cross Creek.
- We created two new committees: 1) For redesigning the and revamping the events within Downs. This will be a slower process then we hoped, but the plan, dedicated funds, and budget are a great start. We now need volunteers, especially for the 4th of July 2) We created the development committee to revise and develop plans for the future and revitalizing the Village. The first part will be revised Land Use Plan and a Strategic Business Plan.
- Washington Street was reconstructed from Seminary to Rt 150 creating the best road in town from the worst. It also drastically improved the water drainange and gave pedestrians a safe place to walk.
- We replaced a stretch of aging water pipe along E. Washignton Street. We still several areas in town that
 contain very old water pipes and this \$90k project replaced a stretch from the Elementary School to Rt 150.
- We added 75 acres to the Village for a 4-Phase 109 home subdivision and new church for Living Hope Christian Church to come later this year.
- We upgraded our financial software to accounting software built for our Village.
- We have started the process to accept electronic payments for utilities, which we hope will be implemented now in June.
- We have implemented a TIF project application process for business' to request TIF money to help with redevelopment within the TIF district. We are committed to increasing commercial business and improving the look of the downtown. These two projects are a great start toward achieving that commitment. We have two new restaurants coming in May or June. Please support these business' whenever possible.
- Event Committee purchased a lighted sign to start advertising upcoming events.

I am finding that our electronic flyer is not effective. I will be taking an idea from Maureen and developing an overview mailer that helps promote important topics you need to know. We also hope to drive more traffic to the website. However, you can still get a hard copy of the full flyer by calling the hall or from the website. Please see the Meeting Overview for information that happened at the Village Board Meeting.

- 3. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Boy Scouts that were in attendance.

Currently, he is focusing on S. Gadwall. The phone line is fixed phone at the lift station. Jeremy has been painting at plant. This should extend the life of the pipes. Kevin is going to start keeping a file of the JULIE's in town. That way we can track of what utility companies working in town.



2014 VILLAGE OF DOWNS FREEDOM RUN & WALK

The 4th annual Village of Downs Freedom Run offers a 5k race timed by the Lake Run Club and a non-timed 1 mile walk, as well as a non-timed Free Kid's Fun Run for children 10 and under.



Registration for the race is available online at

http://www.downsfreedomrun.eventbrite.com now through Fri, June 27, 2014 at Noon. The online registration fee is a \$20.00 donation to the Village of Downs and a \$2.09 Eventbrite fee. Paper forms are available to pre-register with a \$20.00 donation via cash or check (payable to Village of Downs). Checks or cash can be used to register the day of the race (\$25.00 donation) from 6:30 to 7:15 a.m. at Tri-Valley Middle School. No refunds will be given.

Pre-registered runners and walkers may pick up their race packets on Fri, June 27 from 5-7 pm at Tri-Valley High School in Downs, or at the registration table at Tri-Valley Middle School on race day from 6:30 to 7:15 am.

T-shirts (100% cotton) will be given to runners and walkers who have pre-registered online by noon on 6/13/14, or who have mailed forms which have been postmarked by 6/13/14.

The 5k race will start in front of Tri-Valley Middle School at 7:30 am on 6/28/14. Walkers will start immediately following the runners. The 5k Run finish line is on the Tri-Valley High School track. The 1 Mi. Walk finish line is in the TVHS parking lot. The Kids Fun Run will be held after the 5k finishes on the TVHS track. It will be one lap around the track. Kids Fun Run participants do not need to register.

Medals will be awarded to the Overall Top Female and Male, and the Top Age Group Finisher for Men and Women: 19 & under, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, and 60+. Ribbons will be awarded to all children participating in the Fun Run.

Village of Downs Buildings Report

May 1, 2014

The Village of Downs Development Committee met at the Village Hall on April 15, 2014. Review and discussion continued on "The Downs Strategic Development Plan" and the Land Use Plan.

Building permits: 2 permits were issued for homes on Cleveland for additions/sunroom work. A new home permit was issued for a lot in the Cross Creek Subdivision and a permit for a large pool-deck in Mallard Point was also approved.

The Village will be using Zinn Home Inspection Services for our permit inspections in addition to our intergovernmental agreement with the town or Leroy for their Code Enforcement Officer. Kevan Zinn has done inspections for the Village in the past and going forward will be a great resource as additional homes in Cross Creek and new homes in Beecher Trails begin construction possibly later this year.

Michael Freimann, currently the Water/Sewer Trustee, and I will be exchanging responsibilities beginning this month. Although, we have already begun and most likely will continue to work together on Water/Sewer and Buildings duties so other than contact number changes there should be no disruption to either department.

I want to thank Trustee Freimann for all his hard work as Water/Sewer Trustee. He saw the Village through the difficult transition to our Municipal sewer system. He was, if nothing else, extremely fair to all residents in the decisions that needed to be made. I look forward to continuing to work with him and implementing his ideas for improving the Village's water quality.

Please remember to obtain building permits for construction projects, especially those that entail electric and plumbing additions/changes so that the work can be inspected for the safety of the homeowner and the neighboring properties.

<u>Utility-Terrain Vehicle</u> is a self-propelled electrically powered four-wheel motor vehicle or a self-propelled gasoline or diesel powered four wheeled motor vehicle with an engine displacement under 1,200 cubic centimeters which is capable of attaining in one mile speed of more than fifteen miles per hour (15 m.p.h.) but not more than twenty-five miles per hour (25 m.p.h.) and which conforms to the federal regulations under Title 49 C.F.R. Part 571.500

Golf Cart is a motorized vehicle with three or four wheels that is not designed to be operated at a speed of more than twenty-five miles per hour (25 m.p.h.) whose purpose can include, but is not limited to, the playing of golf and is generally designed to carry persons including the driver.

<u>PENALTIES</u>: Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall be punished by a minimum fine of \$75.00. Any second or subsequent offense shall result in the revocation of the permit for a period of not less than three (3) nor more than five (5) years. To the extent that any violation of this Ordinance also constitutes a violation of a criminal statute of the State of Illinois, then the violator shall also be subject to criminal prosecution.




