MARCH 3, 1937

The Board of County Commissioners met this 3rd day of March, 1937 pursuant to adjournment. All members present.

The following resolutions were passed:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it has appeared in the public press that the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works has or is about to approve a system of reservoirs adjacent to and/or including Grand Lake, in Grand County, Colorado, for the purpose of diverting water from the Western Slope of Colorado to the Eastern Slope of Colorado, and the construction of projects for the distribution of electric power, and

WHEREAS, the construction of said projects and the acquisition by purchase or condemnation of the necessary lands by or on the part of the Federal Government would materially reduce the assessment of taxable property in the area affected to the detriment of Grand County, and

WHEREAS, Grand Lake has for many years and now is nationally and internationally famous as a scenic spot and mecca for tourists during the summer months and has prospects of becoming a great winter sports resort for the enjoyment of the people of Colorado and her neighboring States, and

WHEREAS, many fine homes have been erected as summer residences adjacent to and in the vicinity of Grand Lake, and

WHEREAS, the commercialization of the waters of Grand Lake for power and irrigation would have a tendency to pollute the waters of the Lake and the diversion of its waters would hamper the development of Grand County, and

WHEREAS the Honorable Edward T. Taylor, Congressman from the Fourth Congressional District, has and now is waging a determined fight to prevent the diversion and protect the interests of the people of the Western Slope

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Grand, State of Colorado that this Board unequivocally opposes the diversion of the waters of Grand Lake and the evils incident thereto, and that we are in accord with and approve the actions of our Congressman, the Honorable Edward T. Taylor in protesting this proposed diversion.

THAT a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of the proceedings of this Board. That the original be forwarded to Mr. Taylor and authentic copies be forwarded to each of the Congressmen and United States Senators from Colorado.
