It will give our residents and guests a chance to see the transformation that can take place there for future events. A presentation will be made at 6:15pm to address some of the ideas for future uses and ar-

chitectural modifications that have been considered to date. Thanksgiving is just around the corner and that weekend, the Grand Lake Center will be used again on Friday and Saturday, November 27th and 28th for the Olde Fashioned Holiday Craft Bazaar, sponsored by the Grand Lake Arts Council. We have been working for several months on our budget for 2016 and are in the final stages. Our sales tax revenues are up 10%. We contribute approximately \$64,000 to our service organizations in Grand Lake and throughout the County. Many wonderful services are provided as a result. Grand Lake Center Grand Opening



An Open House to celebrate the progress made at the Grand Lake Center as well as the possibilities for future uses has been scheduled for 5:30-7:30 p.m. on Monday, November 16, 2015 at the Center, which was formerly the Grand Lake Elementary School.

The first 45 minutes will be a time for people to enjoy refreshments, view the multi-purpose room as it was prepared for the Disney Way conference and mingle with fellow attendees. At

6:15 p.m., Jeff Wood from the University of Colorado-Denver, Colorado Center for Community Development will then present several potential options for the Center as well as feasibility analysis of those options. It was he and his students that worked with Grand Lake residents to design and transform the multi-purpose room from a gymnasium to a conference center.

The Center, which was purchased earlier this year from the East Grand School District by the Town of Grand Lake, is already utilized by a local church for services and a local group of recreational pickle-ball players.

The recent Disney Way Customer-Service Training that was held in the building is an example of using the Grand Lake Center as a convention center. That training, which attracted nearly 100 people, utilized the multi-purpose room for lectures, group exercises as well as breakfasts and lunches. The classrooms were utilized for break-out sessions. That type of use is an example of a revenue bucket that can support other uses of the building.

Utilization of the Grand Lake Center is still in the envisioning stage and the residents of the Grand Lake area are encouraged to attend the Open House to talk about the vision for future uses and to discuss ways to finance the facility. This invitation is intended to give people the opportunity to get involved at the planning and visioning phase.

Town Ice Rink



The ice skating rink in Town Square Park on the basketball court is anticipated to be completely constructed by Thanksgiving. Though the rink will be set, the freezing of the water and the official opening of the rink will be weather dependant.
