

Seams Like Home Bag Tag

SUPPLIES:

piece of stiff fusible interfacing~Tintex or Peltex	cut 2 1/2" x 11"
fabric for tag	cut 3 1/2" x 12"
fabric for strap	cut 2" x 14"
clear vinyl or plastic	cut 2" x 4"

TAG:

Fold fusible interfacing in half.

Cut the tips off the open end using a ruler.

Lay fabric for tag wrong side up and place fusible interfacing on top with fusible side up. Make sure that the fusible interfacing is placed in the middle of the fabric with about 1/4" of the fabric showing all around it.

Trim the corners of the fabric so the angle of the cut mimics that of the fusible interfacing. This can be done freehand and does not need to be exact. Just make sure to leave about 1/4" of fabric showing under the fusible interfacing.

Carefully bring the fabric sides up over the fusible interfacing and press. Next, press the ends and then press the corners. Fabric will adhere to the interfacing.

STRAP:

Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

Open and press each side into the center crease.

Top stitch down both long sides for a finished edge.

Fold in half and tuck raw edges into the tag about 1/2" down.

Stitch along the strap securing it in place and then continue around the entire tag.

PLASTIC:

Place plastic on top of tag and stitch along the sides and bottom, leaving the top closest to the strap open to insert a business card.

These are fun and easy to make! Use them on any item that needs identification!
