

# Seams Like Home Postcard

## **SUPPLIES:**

piece of stiff double sided fusible interfacing~Tintex or Peltex	cut 4" x 6"
fabric for front	cut 4" x 6"
plain fabric for back	cut 4" x 6"
netting (optional for underwater scene)	cut 4" x 6"
assorted threads for embellishments	
thread for satin stitch edge	

## **POSTCARD FRONT:**

Embellish front however you would like. I used a variety of threads and hand embellished with crazy quilting stitches.

Lay netting over embellished postcard front and tack in place with running stitch.

## **POSTCARD CONSTRUCTION:**

Sandwich plain fabric, fusible interfacing and postcard front together and press.

Trim excess fabric off to create smooth edges.

Satin stitch around the layers to bind them all together. I usually go around the postcard twice.

## **MESSAGE & MAIL:**

Write your message using a permanent sharpie on the plain fabric and mail to your favorite person. A 4"x6" postcard can be successfully mailed with a first class stamp, as long as it does not exceed 1/8" thickness.
