SAFETY ALERT:



FIRE HYDRANTS: In the event there is a fire in your neighborhood, it is crucial that firemen can quickly locate and access fire hydrants. Please help by cleaning the snow 3 feet completely around and away from the hydrants.

CLEANING SIDEWALKS: It is a violation of Salem City Code 7-3-040 to fail to clean the sidewalks of snow and ice in front of and adjacent to a homeowner or occupants property. Please help our children by clearing your sidewalks so they have a safe walking route to school.

ICE ON THE POND: With the cold weather, the pond has started to freeze over and is very unsafe. The ice is **NOT** safe to be on, so please stay off the ice, even around the edges. Please help to keep everyone safe, especially the children and do not let them on the ice.



SNOW PILES ALONG THE ROADS: Please do not allow children to play on the snow piles along the roadways. Cars may not be able to stop in time if a child slides out into the road. Also digging into the piles can be very dangerous. This snow is very unstable and could collapse and bury a child.
