

Commissioner Meeting
April 4, 2016

Chairman Brian Hind called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Ben Fox, Cole Conard, Kathy Robison, County Clerk, and Paul Dean, County Counselor.

Commissioner Fox made a motion to approve March 28, 2016 minutes. Commissioner Conard seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Roger Lowe, Road and Bridge Supervisor, reported that crews will begin working on the culvert in Severy Tuesday of this week; Lowe discussed some issues with the culvert and his plans on fixing it; crews are grading and repairing roads, Lowe asked the commissioners if they wanted to purchase an extended warranty on the mower purchased last week; the commissioners decided to stick with the factory warranty, which includes up to 18 months and 2,000 hours.

Commissioner Hind made a motion for a 5 minute executive session for personnel with Roger Lowe, Road and Bridge Supervisor. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried. An additional 5 minutes was added to the executive session.

No decision was made.

The commissioners said they will be doing a road viewing next Monday @ 11:30 a.m. and would like Roger Lowe, Road and Bridge Supervisor to go along.

No Treasurer's Report this week.

Commissioner Conard made a motion to approve payables in the amount of \$6,892.27. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Fox made a motion to approve abatements in the amount of \$661.98. Commissioner Conard seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Fox made a motion to approve adds in the amount of \$945.70. Commissioner Conard seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Conard made a motion to approve the employment status change for V. Jason Findley, Building Maintenance Supervisor, to change his pay to \$13.25 per hour. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The commissioners viewed a Certificate of Liability for Voice Product, Inc.

The commissioners received a letter from KDOT regarding their Federal Funds for 2016. Greenwood County was granted \$111,681.14 and is expected to participate in KDOT's Federal Funds Exchange Program, in which they will be held to state requirements for road construction instead of the more strict federal requirements.

Sheriff Rusty Bitler informed the commissioners that he has been working with the department's insurance company in regards to a department vehicle being totaled last week in a chase. The employee in the vehicle was not injured. The Sheriff's Department plans to pay the deductible then search for a vehicle to replace the one that was totaled.

The commissioners discussed the upcoming SEK meeting that Greenwood County is to host this year.

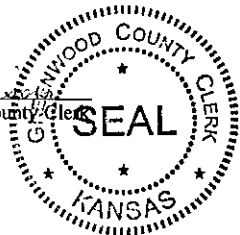
At 10:00 a.m. Commissioner Conard made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.
