NEWS FROM TOWN HALL

INFORMATION – Town Hall Closed: The Town Hall will also be closed on Thursday, December 25th and Friday, December 26th for the Christmas Holiday's and will re-open for business on Monday, December 29, 2014.

INFORMATION Tree Lighting & Town Christmas Tree: The Christmas Tree will be placed at the intersection of 4th & San Juan Avenue for the holiday season. Please be cautious while driving around this area.

The Town will be lighting the Town Christmas Tree on Saturday, December 6th at 5:00 p.m. Carols will be sung and goody bags handed out.

There will also be other events going on December 6th; Friends of Library will be holding their 4th annual holiday bazaar at the Community Building from 9a.m. to 3 p.m.; The Welcome Center is doing an open house; The Ute Theatre is going to have students performing Christmas carols and a short performance by Saguache Community Theatre Company. Look for more information in the coming weeks.

INFORMATION- Street Lights: Please call the Town Hall at 655-2232 to report problems with street lights. The clerks will contact Xcel Energy to get the problem fixed.

REMINDER – Snow Removal Tips: Just as a reminder. Please remember to park on the side streets when it snows. The Town will plow street in this priority: 4th Street [Gunnison Avenue south to Pitkin Avenue]. Denver Avenue [1st Street to 14th Street]. Pitkin Avenue [2nd Street to 8th Street]. Christy Avenue [2nd Street to 14th Street]. San Juan Avenue [1st Street to 14th Street].

The Town will then begin plowing streets running north and south, beginning with 1st Street. CDOT plows Hwy 285.

The Town will plow the roads when 3 inches or more of snow has accumulated.

If you notice a large amount of snow accumulating, please remember if you want snow to be plowed in front of your residence along the street, your vehicle/vehicles must be moved from the street prior to when the Town starts plowing (which is normally around 5:00 a.m.). As the Town is trying to remove snow throughout the town they may only be able to go by your residence one time. Parked vehicles are difficult for the snow removal equipment to maneuver around, and that area will not be plowed.

The Town does not plow alleyways, so if you use that as your parking or main access to your property, you are responsible to clear a pathway.

REMINDER: The 2015 Water and Sewer Payment Booklets are in the process of being printed. We expect that your booklet will be available at the Town Hall the 1st of December.
