REMINDER Water Restrictions Lifted: The Board has lifted the water restrictions effective September 1, 2014. The town is encouraging you to avoid watering in the heat of the day. When watering your yard please remember not to leave the water on one spot for more than an hour. Thank you for your cooperation.

REMINDER- DOGS NOT TO RUN AT LARGE: If you own a dog within the Town of Saguache per Ordinance 2011-3, Section 3: Running at Large prohibited. No dog owner shall fail to exercise proper care and control of his or her dog(s) to prevent them from becoming a public nuisance. No person shall permit any dog(s) of which he or she is the owner, caretaker or custodian to run at large within the Town.

REMINDER – CLEANING UP AFTER YOUR DOG: Please remember while you are taking your dog(s) for walks throughout town, please clean up after them. Also please avoid letting them urinate on town property (i.e. benches, light poles, etc...), especially on 4th Street. The town has also placed “mutt mitt” collection bags at Otto Mears Park for your use. Thank you.

MOSQUITO SPRAYING SEASON OVER: Public Works will no longer be spraying for mosquitoes for the 2014 season.
