Size: 8 1/2 " by 12" opened

Class Description: In this class you will receive instructions for the completion of a basic wallet and demonstration of different closures: snaps, Velcro, and magnetic. You might find this wallet will become your favorite to use and gift.

Fabric:

There are many different color ways. Here are two:

All one color: ¾ yard of fabric

<u>Like Sample</u>: ½ yard for outside, inside, and zippered pouch

1/4 yard for binding, credit card holder and pen loop

¼ yard Fleece

2" by 27" lightweight interfacing

Supplies:	Feet:	Misc
7" zipper to match	#37, or 57, or 97D	Cutting Board
505 Adhesive Spray	#1C, #4, #10,	6" by 24" Ruler
Silk pins	Walking Foot	Rotary Cutter
Closure		Extra Needles

Scissors

Prior to class:

Wash and press all fabric.

Notes from Instructor:

Batik fabric is particularly well suited for wallets. It is durable and holds up well under the constant use. If you haven't tried Ellen's Best Press, now might be a good time. I like it so much I buy the gallon refills. One last thing, you can bring a snack of any kind to class.
