Prizes, collectibles and more fun!

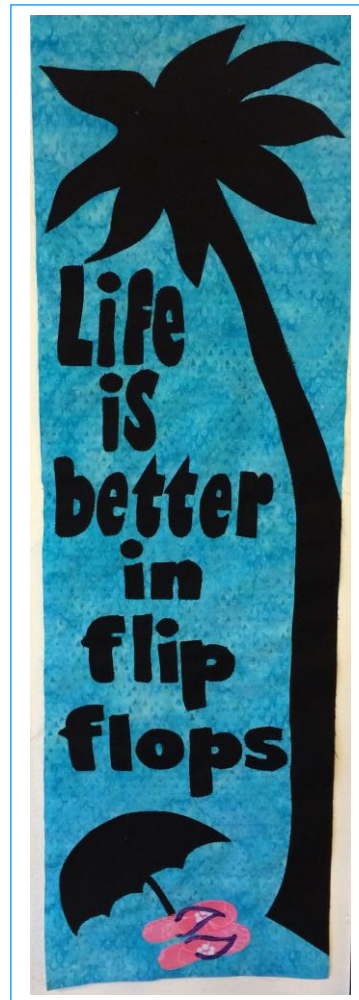

Favorite Recipes

Taco Braid
 (I actually made this last night for dinner! It was really good!!!)



1. In a skillet, brown 1lb of ground meat. Season with your favorite taco seasoning. When meat is just cooked through add half of a small onion and let cook a few minutes. Adding the onion now keeps it slightly crunchy. Rinse and drain 1- 15oz can of black beans. Add to meat. (I just used a can of refried beans) Drain 1 can of rotel tomatoes. Add to meat. Heat till mixture is hot through out.
2. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper (makes clean up easy). Roll out 1 package of crescent roll onto baking sheet. Mend the perforations.
3. Cut crescent sheet on both sides 1inch apart. A pizza cutter works well
4. Put cooked meat mixture in center of crescent sheet
5. Put 2 cups of grated cheddar cheese on top of meat mixture
6. Fold crescent strips over meat mixture and press the strips together to seal the braid.
7. Bake in 350° oven for 20-25 minutes or until golden brown
8. Let sit for 5-10minutes to allow the Taco Braid to set. Serve and enjoy.

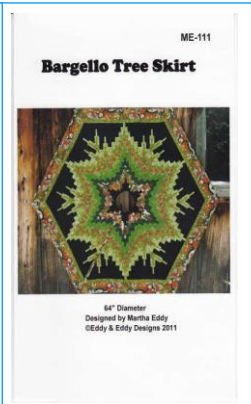
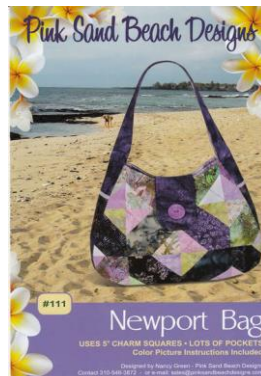

Class Policy

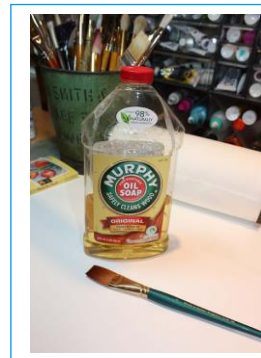
All classes are filled on a first-come, first serve basis. Classes fill FAST and are limited in size.

Well don't throw it away so fast. Bob Burridges has great tips and this is one that works! He washes all of his brushes with Murphy's Oil Soap and makes them all like new. If you petrify a brush just soak it in Murphys for 24 to 48 hours and it dissolves all the paint and makes it like new. This brush is like new again. Good ole Murpheys! It's magic stuff!
