

Class Name: Daisy Tote Bag

Instructor: Joyce Cambron

Supplies Needed: Book Purchase Required: *A New Spin on Curved Piecing*

The outside shell of the tote is pieced and quilted before pockets and lining are added. Our first class will be about piecing the Daisy motif center of the tote front. In the second class, we'll learn to make our own piping to trim various features of the bag and add pockets to the back and lining.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Daisy Background of Daisy motif...Fat Quarter
Daisy Petals.....up to four ¼ yard cuts of coordinating fabrics or scraps at least 9" square
Daisy Center and Accent Piping... 1/4 yard

Body of Bag

Focus Fabric....3/4 yard Straps, back pocket, bottom and sides of the bag
Co-ordinate....2/3 yard underside of straps, back of bag, inside pockets
Lining....1 yard
Quilt backing...3/4 yard of muslin or other light-weight stabilizing fabric for internal quilting
Batting...3/4 yard or crib quilt size

Piping 5 yards of rat tail cording or 2 packages of manufactured piping

Warning: Certain fabrics which have been brought to class have had a bad reaction to having freezer paper ironed onto them; most recently, a batik from Moda. You may want to test your fabrics by setting your iron at a high (Cotton or Linen) setting and pressing a scrap of Freezer Paper onto the right side of the fabric. If the Freezer Paper doesn't peel off easily, you may want to save that fabric for another project. The Moda fabric I mentioned WOULD NOT let go of the Freezer Paper, and the section it was ironed onto was ruined.

SUPPLIES: I will provide patterns of the Daisy for students to trace in class.

Sewing machine and basic sewing supplies	Rotary Cutter, matt, and ruler at least 18"
Freezer Paper from roll – 18" square	Fine-point Sharpie in Black
Roxanne's Basting Glue	Wash-out fabric markers
Paper and Fabric Scissors	Small, inexpensive paint brush
For Piping: Cording presser foot	
Add-a-Quarter Ruler	

Optional but helpful supplies:

While irons and boards are supplied in the classroom, it can be helpful to bring your own tabletop models.
