

Yo-Yo Cat

You will need:

- Small Clover Yo-Yo Maker (green)
- Large Clover Yo-Yo Maker (orange)
- X-Large Clover Yo-Yo Maker (yellow)
- Jumbo Clover Yo-Yo Maker (blue)
- Black fabric
- 2 Pipe Cleaners
- 2" styrafoam ball, painted black
- Broom Straw or Jute for whiskers
- 2 Straight pins with beads for eyes
- Base and dowel



Tail: take a 2" x 5" piece of black fabric. Fold it long way and baste together, leave one end open for turning inside out. Place a pipe cleaner inside fabric and shape with a curl.

Head: Cut pipe cleaner into two 2" pieces and fold into ear shape—stick in head. With fingernail, push into the styrafoam some eye shapes, paint them green and place some beads with straight pins in the center. Cut broom straw or jute into whiskers, glue onto nose followed by a button.

Using the Clover Yo-Yo Maker, make

- 1 small yo-yo (green)
- 3 large yo-yo's (orange)
- 3 X-Large yo-yo's (yellow)
- 3 Jumbo yo-yo's (blue)

Do not pull one of the X-Large yo yo's all the way—we want it to be a size inbetween.

Cut a small hole in the backside of each yo-yo.

Start with the base and glue dowel in place

Stack 1 Jumbo, tail (curl pipe cleaner onto dowel) 2 Jumbo, 1 modified yo –yo, 2 X-Large, 3 Large, 1 Small and Head.

When you are happy with the body of cat, remove head, cover dowel with glue and replace head.

Tie a pretty ribbon around neck.
