1-6-1: COUNCIL-MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT:

Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated section 10-3b-103(6), the Town Council hereby adopts and establishes a council-manager form of government and further establishes the office of town manager. (Ord. 88-003, 4-12-1988; amd. 2010 Code)

1-6-2: PREPARATION OF MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATIVE CODE:

It shall be the duty of the first manager appointed under the provisions of this chapter to draft and submit to the Town Council, within six (6) months after assuming office, a proposed ordinance providing for the division of the administrative service of the town into departments, divisions and bureaus, and defining the functions and duties of each. Subsequent to the adoption of such ordinance, upon recommendation of the Town Manager, the Town Council, by ordinance, may create, consolidate or abolish departments, divisions and bureaus, and define or alter the functions and duties of each. The compilation of these ordinances shall be known as the municipal administrative code. Prior to the adoption of the municipal administrative code, the Town Manager shall have the power to establish temporary rules and regulations to ensure efficiency and effectiveness in divisions of the municipal government.
