4. Other Business
  - a. Sheriff Clint Pollock Yearly Report-Sheriff Perkins on speakerphone. He went over some of the numbers, and is seeking input on how many days they will patrol for the year. The Sheriff will do his best to accommodate our needs this year. We will shoot between 22 and \$23,000 for 2013. 623 vehicles were stopped; more than half were for speeding. We have the report here in the town office if anyone would like to view it.

  - b. Annual Hwy 12 report-John Holland-John was here reporting on what is going on on highway 12. Red Canyon Visitor Center improvements are going on now. UDOT markers on the road are being updated with "Scenic Byway 12 All-American Road" identification where the SR12 signs are located. The junction of US 89 and SR12 is complete and other locations will be updated by UDOT

Region 4 as time and budget allows. Pullouts along SR12 are being widened for safety reasons. He gave us a handout that is here at the office for anyone to view if you would like.

- c. Chaplin David Jones w/Army Utah National Guard
  - i. He presented Community Covenant; it is about relationships with cities and towns with the Army National Guard. It was started in 2008 by the department of the Army. “The mission of the UTNG Community Covenant program is to foster and sustain formal, continuing relationships with communities in order to increase the quality of life, well being, and readiness of Service-members/Veterans and their families.” Steps include: Draft a city resolution that designates a “Military Liaison” and/or authorizes a Community Covenant. Organize a Community Covenant Signing Ceremony. Ongoing Commitment and Programming (work with Military Liaison).
