Klay handed out our original contract for snow removal. When the contract was done up originally the Fire Station was not built, they figured in \$1,500.00 to remove snow at fire station for the winter.

They did not bill us for 2012, but did in 2013.

It is \$15,000.00 a year for snow removal for a year. The breakdown is 2010-11 \$13,500, 2011-12 \$13,500, 2012-13 \$13,500, 2012-13 Fire station parking lot \$1,500. Total is \$42,000.

There is also a bill for gravel for the park when we paved parking spaces and to do the radius for some of our turns on the roads. \$3,000.00.

The bill for water and sewer for the city is as follows: Shuttle \$750.00, Shuttle lawns \$399.86, Cemetery \$549.00, Park \$263.06 for a total of \$1961.92.

Grand total is \$46,962.92
