



# 2013 Landscape Irrigation Product Rebates

## Rebate Program Rules:

- Rebates apply to qualifying items (full lists at [www.weberbasin.com/conservation](http://www.weberbasin.com/conservation) ) purchased between Jan. 1, 2013 and Dec. 31, 2013. No exceptions.
- Rebate recipients must live in Davis, Weber, Morgan or Summit counties. The products purchased must be installed on properties within those counties.
- All rebate applications must be accompanied by a valid original sales receipt. A valid receipt shows date purchased, manufacturer name/make and model number of product or sku number from retail store, price for each item, and vendor. The valid receipt must indicate the item is paid-in-full. (contractor purchase and install see contractor policy)
- Online purchases must show the manufacturer make and model of the irrigation controller or product. Purchases must show a “paid” status.
- Application forms without complete information or a valid receipt will not be processed and will be returned to the applicant.
- If a rebate is received, each residential property/applicant will not be eligible to receive additional rebates for the exact product for the next 5 years.

- All rebate applications must be submitted within 90 days of the purchase date. No exceptions.
- Only the products on the approved product list qualify for rebate. See full list at [www.weberbasin.com/conservation](http://www.weberbasin.com/conservation) Maximum rebates apply to each product category.
- Failure to cash a rebate check within 90 days of issuance shall void the rebate and shall relieve Weber Basin Water Conservancy District of any obligation to pay the rebate. Rebate checks cannot be reissued.
- Make a copy of the entire application and your purchase receipt, and keep the copy for your records.

The Landscape Irrigation Product Rebate is a conservation program of Weber Basin Water Conservancy District. The program will continue through Dec. 2013 or until budgeted funds are depleted. Weber Basin Water Conservancy District reserves the right to cancel or modify the program as any time. Rebates are offered independently of any sale prices or rebates that may be concurrently offered by manufacturers or vendors.

- Allow 4-6 weeks for your completed application to be processed and your rebate to be received.
- Original receipt must be attached unless sent in by fax or e-mail.

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**Residential rebates for “smart” controllers (soil moisture/weather based) using on-site soil moisture or weather data.**

**Receive 50% off the purchase price or maximum of \$150.00** on the purchase of a “smart” controller. If the “smart” controller uses on-site weather data or soil moisture data (data collected on that property with the use of a rain gauge, temperature sensor, soil sensors, and other weather sensors) instead of a remote weather service (collects data from close weather source/station by radio or digital signal), the on-site weather based controller must have the following (at a minimum):

- Solar radiation and/or temperature sensors
- Rain shut-off device (rain sensor or tipping bucket)

**Residential rebates for “smart” controllers and weather based controllers using remote weather data (receives a signal for weather station).**

Receive 50% off the purchase price or maximum \$150.00 when you purchase one of the following “smart” controllers. Weather-based smart controllers use weather data from remote weather stations via radio, pager or Internet signals. A rain shut-off device (rain sensor or tipping bucket) should be used in conjunction with the remote weather source.

**Definitions**

- **Complete Replacement:** An ET controller that replaces the existing controller, including the base unit, with a weather-based smart controller and corresponding components.
- **ET:** Abbreviation for evapotranspiration, the measure of evaporation from the soil and transpiration from plants.
- **On-site:** Refers to weather information gathered by sensors placed on the property and connected to the controller. The data may be conveyed through wires or radio frequency.
- **Rain shut off device:** Device that prevents the controller from activating the valves when a preset amount of rain falls. Types of rain shut-off devices include rain sensors and tipping buckets.
- **Remote:** Refers to weather information gathered by sensors at another location such as a regional weather station. The data may be conveyed to the controller through satellite, radio frequency, Internet or phone lines.
- **Retrofit/Add-on:** Software or components which are attached to a compatible, existing irrigation controller. The software/components convert a standard controller into a weather-based ET controller.
- **Sensors:** Any of several products that quantify weather conditions used by weather-based ET controllers. Sensors include: solar radiation, precipitation, wind and barometric pressure.

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## Residential Rebates for Low Precipitation Rotary Spray Nozzles

Weber Basin Water Conservancy District will rebate **50% off the purchase cost** of high-efficiency or rotary nozzles (maximum rebate for nozzles of \$150.00).

### Hunter MP Rotator Nozzles

- Qualifying applications require the replacement of nozzles on all heads for an entire zone. Inspections may be required for compliance.
- Controller run times may need to be increased.
- Matched precipitation rate streams improves coverage
- For use on 8 -30' spray patterns

### Rain Bird Rotary Nozzles

- Qualifying applications require the replacement of nozzles on all heads for an entire zone. Inspections may be required for compliance.
- Controller run times may need to be increased.
- Matched precipitation rate streams improves coverage
- For use on 13 -24' spray patterns

### Toro Precision Series Rotating Nozzles

- Qualifying applications require the replacement of nozzles on all heads for an entire zone. Inspections may be required for compliance.
- Controller run times may need to be increased.
- Matched precipitation rate streams improves coverage
- For use on 16 - 24' spray patterns

### Toro Precision Series Nozzles

- Qualifying applications require the replacement of nozzles on all heads for an entire zone. Inspections may be required for compliance.
- Matched precipitation rate streams improves coverage
- For use on 2-15' spray patterns

## Residential Rebates for Select Spray and Rotor Heads

Receive 50% off the purchase price or maximum of \$150.00 on the purchase of select spray and rotor heads that include pressure regulation built in and allow for better efficiency and better coverage. Requirement is that all heads on one zone must be replaced so that the full benefit is realized on one zone. No single head rebates will be honored. Inspection of the site may be requested to verify the install of the rebated products.

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## Contractor Purchase and Installation Policy

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**Contractors may not submit rebate applications for purchase and installation of equipment with the exception of new construction where a full irrigation system is installed.**

If you are a contractor and wish to assist homeowners in receiving a rebate for products that you purchase and install for them, you will need to provide the homeowner with an invoice which shows clearly the product or item installed, the quantity (in the case of nozzles), and the retail cost (their cost) for that product not including labor. The invoice needs to be detailed enough as to leave no question about the brand, exact product installed, the date of installation and the address where products were installed.

A price comparison will be made between your submitted product cost (on invoice provided to your customer) and the suggested retail cost for the product from the manufacturer. Homeowners will not receive a rebate which exceeds 50% of the suggested retail cost for any product. The program is intended to assist you as a contractor in promoting your business and helping homeowners receive some savings off of the total cost of the job you are performing, while receiving good products. If you are charging too much for a controller and the homeowner submits a rebate application, they will know they were not treated fairly based on their rebated amount which will be based on the average retail cost of that item locally.

The overall objective of this program is intended to assist water users in becoming more efficient with irrigation scheduling, therefore reducing wasted water while maintaining the desired level of quality in the landscape. Please be conscientious and help homeowners be more efficient. If needed, please suggest to the homeowner that there are free resources available to help them manage their irrigation and become more efficient. These programs include:

1. A free water check (takes an hour and will help homeowners with proper scheduling)
2. Free landscape classes (held in Layton at the Learning Garden, visit [www.weberbasin.com/conservation](http://www.weberbasin.com/conservation) for details).
3. The Learning Garden (2 acre garden, open free to the public to provide ideas and education about plants, irrigation, soils, lawns, etc.

We encourage you as contractors to continue to do the quality work you have been doing. It is our desire to work with you and help educate homeowners about the need for properly designed and installed irrigation systems with the best products. The outcome will be healthy, beautiful landscapes which require and use much less water.
