West Bountiful City is pleased to announce that it has awarded Ace Disposal a contract to collect residential waste and recycle materials beginning July 1, 2015. Ace Disposal is a local Utah company with a long tradition of quality services, and currently provides collections in Bountiful and Centerville. This new contract is the result of months of work by the City to ensure that residents receive the best value in waste collection services.

Here's what residents need to know about the new contract (beginning in July):

- Residents will keep their current containers for waste and recycle material.
- Collection schedules will stay the same. If your collection day has been Monday, it will continue to be Monday. Recycle collection will continue to be every 2 weeks on the same day as your waste collection. The first recycle collection days will be July 6-7.
- Collections will begin at 7am on collection days.
- On collection days if your container has been missed or you have other similar problems, Ace Disposal has a local customer service center. You can reach their customer service representative by calling 801-363-9995.
- If you are disabled and need assistance with having your container brought to the curb, please contact the City Offices at 801-292-4486.
- If your container is damaged or missing, please contact the City Offices at 801-292-4486.
- The City will continue to host annual Spring and Fall Clean-up at the City Park.
