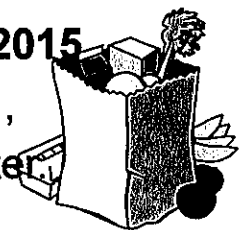



A Frontier Christmas Parade – Light up your parade entry!

PLEASE KEEP THIS INSTRUCTION SET FOR REFERENCE THE DAY OF THE EVENT.

Parade Registration and Route Instructions

Parade lineup: 3:30 p.m. for 4:30 p.m. start - Revised

Only preregistered entries will be considered for prize money due to the increase size of the parade the past few years. There are 4 overall divisions in the parade: Children (ages 3-12), Organizations/Floats and Cars/Trucks/ATV and Horses.

- **PARADE REGISTRATION** will be at 224 S. Poplar at the City's maintenance shop.
- **Children's Division** will organize and stage on Poplar between Second and Third (In front of the City shop).
- **Organizations/Floats** will stage from the intersection of Third and Poplar to Elm and North on Elm as needed .
- **Cars/Trucks/ATV** will stage south of Third and Poplar (bus barn area) and at available school parking stalls on Third.
- **Horses** will stage at the South High School parking lot at First and School Street. After unloading, horses/riders will travel south on Elm to Third and Poplar to the parking area just east of the City Maintenance Shop to follow behind the cars and trucks.

Children's (ages 3-12) Parade Route

The Children's Division will be leading the parade this year. Children will begin at Third and Poplar and go west on Third to Forrest, turn South on Forrest to Fourth Street, turn East on Fourth and go to the Seal Elementary School parking lot at Fourth and Willow. Parents are encouraged to walk with smaller children or to meet their children at the Fourth/Willow parking lot location.

Parade Route: Organization/Floats – Cars/Trucks/ATV – Horses

The parade will travel west on Third from Poplar to Forrest, turn South on Forrest to Sixth Street, then turn East to and travel to Pecan. Horses can travel North on Elm back to the High School parking lot. Organizations/Floats and Cars/Trucks/ATVs can disperse unless a trailer has been left at the staging area.

Reminder: ATV's and all off-road vehicles will be allowed in the parade, but must be brought to and from the parade by trailer. Violators will be ticketed per State Law.

The 2015 A Frontier Christmas Parade will be at 4:30 pm on Saturday, November 21, 2015. The staging of the Parade will begin at 3:30 pm at 224 S. Poplar at the City's Maintenance Shop. This year's parade will have 4 divisions: Children (ages 3-12), Organizations/Floats and Cars/Trucks/ATV and Horses. **PLEASE NOTE: ATV's and all off-road vehicles will be allowed in the parade, but must be brought to and from the parade by trailer. Violators will be ticketed per State Law.**

The Friends of the Library will be judging and awarding prizes of \$25.00 for the best entry in each division – as this event has a holiday theme – please consider lighting up your parade entry! For safety reasons NO CANDY is to be thrown, but candies, balloons, etc. can be handed out along the route.



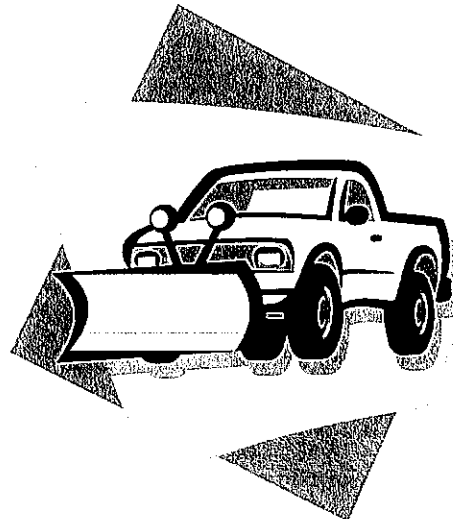

Ice and Snow Removal: It won't be long until winter arrives, bringing with it all the beauty and headaches of ice and snow. As a reminder, the City's policy for ice and snow removal is listed below.

The City's snow removal policy is to remove snow and treat for ice on all streets in the City. The intent is to make the streets as safe as possible during winter storm events. The top priorities are commercial areas, followed by residential streets. Please park cars off the streets where possible so snow can be plowed to the curb and edge of pavement. The City is not responsible for removing snow that has been plowed into driveway areas. Cul-de-sacs are difficult in terms of snow removal and may not receive the same treatment as other streets. First Street through town is maintained by Butler County. Highway 77 going through town is maintained by the Kansas Department of Transportation.

Trash and Recycling Note:

Thursday trash and recycling pickups will be on Friday, November 27 due to the Thanksgiving Holiday.
