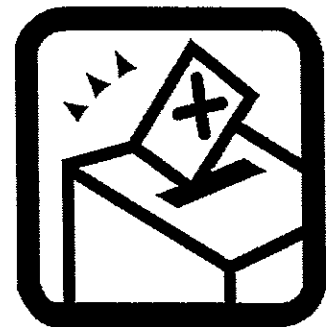

A number of phone numbers in the City's system are no longer working numbers. This information will only be used if there is an urgent situation such as a water leak or other utility emergency or animal control issue which requires us to contact citizens.

PLEASE IDENTIFY YOUR HOME OR BUSINESS WITH A VISIBLE STREET ADDRESS NUMBER!

Is your home or business clearly numbered and identified? Please check! In order for deliveries and more importantly, emergency personnel, to be able to locate and respond to your needs, appropriate numbering of homes and businesses is absolutely critical. For a complete copy of Ordinance 598, which addresses numbering all buildings including duplexes and apartments and trailer courts, please call or come by City Hall.



Inoperable Vehicles:

As a reminder, it is a violation of city ordinance to have on private property for more than 30 days a vehicle that is not currently tagged or registered; parked in violation of city ordinance; incapable of moving under its own power; or in a junked, wrecked or inoperable condition. This reminder is to allow owners of such vehicles the opportunity to correct the situation before citations are issued by the City.
