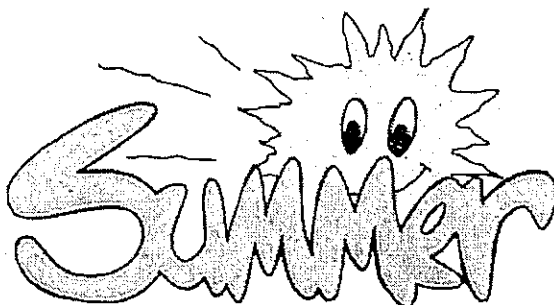

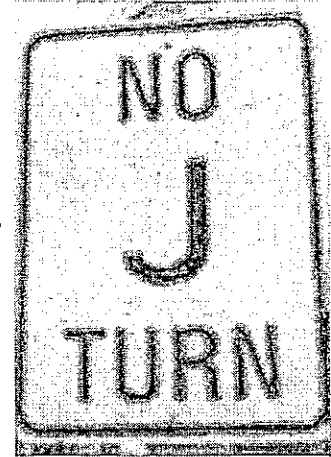

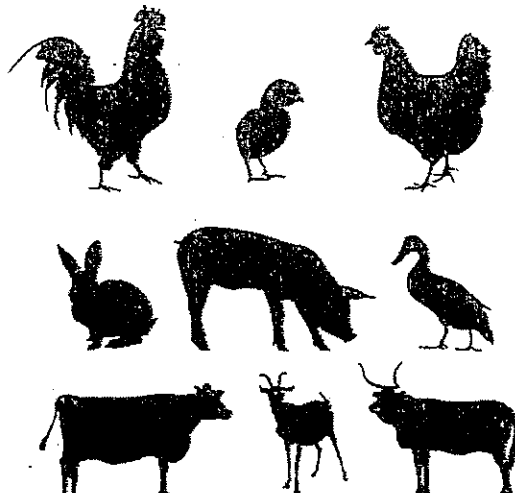
### Traffic Reminders:

In the Central Business district, designated as Forrest Street from 2nd to 4th Street and 3rd Street from Maple to Walnut Street, J-turns are not legal and can result in a traffic citation being issued. A J-turn is crossing a double yellow line to enter a parking stall on the opposite side of the street. This law is in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians and drivers alike.....

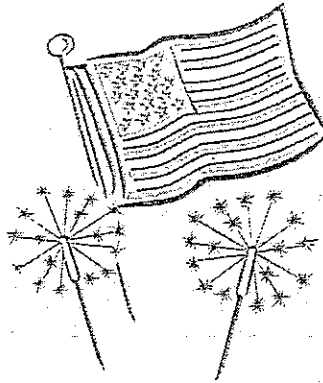

Ordinance 642 allows the discharge of State Fire Marshall approved fireworks within the City of Douglass. The discharge of these fireworks is permitted only at the following times and dates:

8:00 AM – 10:00 PM	June 27 – July 3
8:00 AM – MIDNIGHT	July 4
10:00 AM – 10:00 PM	July 5

**PENALTY** – The violation regarding the discharge of fireworks shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,500.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than one (1) year.

Please celebrate safely and use good common sense when handling fireworks. Listed below are a few safety tips from the Office of the Kansas State Fire Marshal:

- \*Purchase high quality fireworks from reliable and legitimate dealers. Bottle rockets, skyrockets, or any item mounted on a stick or wire is prohibited for sale, use, or possession in Kansas per KSA 31-155.
- \*Obey all local laws and ordinances. Be careful in congested/populated and dry open field areas.
- \*Read and follow instructions printed on the packaging.
- \*Have an adult supervise all fireworks activities.
- \*Use fireworks only in clear areas, away from streets, buildings, or dry grass.
- \*Have water handy.
- \*Keep everyone at a safe distance after each firework is lit.
- \*Do not attempt to re-light any fireworks that fail to discharge – dispose of in a safe manner.

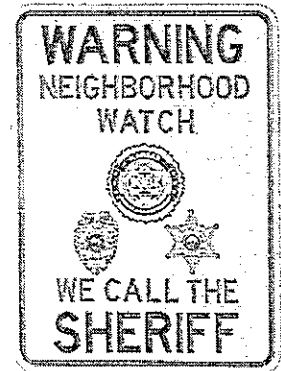

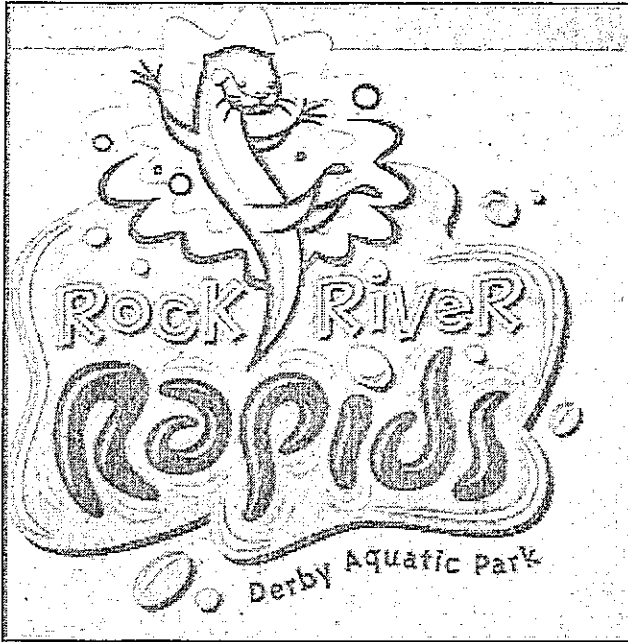
