$121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square white
$121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles of 4 different fabrics


## Tenlee's Hopes

 $56 "$ x 68 "Fabric
$2 \quad 21 / 2$ " strips of 28 different fabrics
$1121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips white or $7 / 8$ yard.
$1 / 2$ yard of binding
Backing $31 / 2$ yds. of 45 " or 66 " of wide backing
Batting 66" x 78"

Cutting for the quilt
Print strips
$1221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from each print (336 pieces)
$121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to use in the border ( 28 pieces)
White
$8421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sq. from 5 of the white strips
The rest is used in the first border.
Make 84 quilt blocks. You will use 80 blocks in the quilts. Sew 8 in a row and make 10 rows.
Sew the strips end to end. Measure through the quilts center side to side. Cut that length and sew to the sides. Repeat for the top and bottom.
For the outer border sew the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles end to end. Sew to the quilt in the same method as the blocks were sewn.
