ORDINANCE NO. 1998-1

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS IN COALVILLE CITY; PROHIBITING PARKING ON PUBLIC SIDEWALKS; PROHIBITING THE DEPOSIT OR DISTRIBUTION OF SNOW OR OTHER MATERIAL UPON A CITY STREET OR SIDEWALK; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1980-4.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF COALVILLE CITY AS FOLLOWS:

1. Parking on Public Streets. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave unattended any vehicle or other obstruction within twenty (20) feet of the center line of the street, or in instances where curb is installed, between the curb and center line upon any street in Coalville during the hours of 1:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M. from the first day of November through the last day of March of each year. No vehicle or other obstructions shall be parked within thirty (30) feet of any intersection at any time.

2. Parking on Public Sidewalks. It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle on any public sidewalk.

3. Deposit of Snow or Other Obstructions on Public Ways. It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit or distribute snow or any other material or obstruction on any public street or sidewalk without first receiving permission from Coalville City.

4. Removal - Costs. Employees of Coalville City are hereby authorized to remove or have removed at their direction any vehicle or other obstruction left in a street or sidewalk in violation of this Ordinance and any person who parks, leaves or deposits any such vehicle or other obstruction and the owner of the same shall be liable for the cost of removal.

5. Enforcement. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class B Misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine or by imprisonment, not to exceed six (6) months, or by both a fine and imprisonment.

6. Repeal of Ordinance No. 1980-4. This Ordinance supercedes and replaces Ordinance No. 1980-4 entitled "Ordinance Prohibiting Parking on Certain Streets and Sidewalks in Coalville City" and said Ordinance is hereby repealed.

7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its passage and upon one publication in the Summit County Bee, a newspaper having general circulation in Coalville City.
