## ORDINANCE NO. 14

An ordinance concerning the levying and collecting of a poll TAX.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of this City of Haven.

Section 1. That all able bodied male persons, between the age of twenty-one and fifty years, residing in the city of Haven, shall pay to said city each year the sum of one dollar poll tax in each year.

Section 2. It shall be, and is hereby made the duty of the city clerk on or before the twenty-first day of August of each year, to make out and deliver to the county clerk of Reno county, a complete list of persons liable to pay a poll tax, as provided in section one of this ordinance; which said list shall specify the amount of poll tax opposite each person's name, and shall be placed upon the tax roll to be collected as provided by the laws of the State of Kansas.

Section 3. This ordinance to be in full force and effect from and after its publication. Approved August 5, 1901 (First publication August 10.)
