## ORDINANCE NO. 1

## AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR REGULAR AND SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Be it ordained by Mayor and Councilmen of the city of Haven.

Section 1. That regular meetings of the City Council of the city of Haven shall be held on the second and fourth Mondays of each and every month at seven o'clock P.M. or at such other hour of said days as the council may see fit.

Section 2. Special meetings of the city council may be held at anytime upon the request of three members of the council.

Section 3. Such request shall be direct to the Mayor and shall set forth the object and time for the proposed special meeting.

Section 4. Upon receipt of the notice aforesaid, the mayor shall forthwith issue a notice to the city council stating the object of the meeting called and shall designate the time of same agreeably to the request, unless for good cause the mayor shall appoint some other time which said notice shall be served by the city marshall personally upon each member of the council, the city clerk and city attorney.

Section 5. The said request shall be read at the meeting and spread at large upon the record and at any special meeting it shall be unlawful to transact any business than that set forth in the request for same.

Section 6. A majority of the council shall be necessary at any time to constitute a quorum but a smaller number may adjourn from time to time.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication. Approved this July 22, 1901
