## **ORDINANCE NO. 21**

Be it ordained by the mayor and the councilmen of the city of Haven, Kansas.

Section 1. That a poll tax of one dollar per annum on all able bodied males, who are inhabitants of the city of Haven, between the years of twenty-one and fifty is hereby imposed.

Section 2. It is hereby made the duty of the city clerk to make and certify a list of all the male inhabitants of the city of Haven each year, between the ages of twenty-one and fifty years, who are liable to pay poll tax and deliver said list to the city treasurer.

Section 3. It is hereby made the duty of the city treasurer upon receipt of the list specified in the preceding section, at once without delay to collect the above described poll tax and to place the amount collected to the credit of the general fund and to report the amount collected to the council with other reports.

Section 4. Any one violating this ordinance by refusing to pay said poll tax when requested by the city treasurer, so to do shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined not exceeding ten dollars.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its publication in the Haven Journal.
