ORDINANCE NO. 25 (Repealed)

PROHIBITING THE SALE OF NON-INTOXICATING BEVERAGES, THE SAME BEING THE PRODUCT OF A BREWERY, AND PROVIDING PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAVEN:

SECTION 1. The sale, by any person, of any non-intoxicating beverage, the same being the product of a brewery and being known as Malt, B.B., Hop T., or by any other name whatsoever, is hereby prohibited. SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of section one of this ordinance, shall, upon

SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of section one of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be fined in any sum not less than Twenty dollars, nor more than Fifty dollars.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the official paper of the city.
