

ORDINANCE NO. 304

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN STREETS IN AND NEAR SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONES IN THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS:

Section 1. For the purpose of controlling traffic to provide safety for school children during the time school buses are loading between the hours of 3:55 PM and 4:10 PM on days in which school is in session, Fourth Street, from Sedgwick Avenue to the Alley running north and south in Block 2, Henry Astle's First Addition, shall be closed to vehicular traffic.

Section 2. Vehicular traffic on Sedgwick Avenue between Fourth Street and Fifth Street shall be one-way traffic north-bound during the time as set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than five (\$5.00) dollars nor more than ten (\$10.00) dollars.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication once in the Haven Journal, the official City paper.
