AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO C. R. EATON HIS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS THE RIGHT OF WAY ALONG THE STREETS AND ALLEYS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES OF THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, MAINTAINING AND OPERATING A TELEPHONE EXCHANGE.

Section 1. Be it ordained by the mayor and council of the city of Haven.

The right of way and privilege is hereby granted to C. R. Eaton his successors and assigns to construct, maintain and operate a telephone exchange in the city of Haven, Kansas for a period of twenty (20) years from the date hereof, and under the direction of the street committee to place and maintain poles, wire, cables, and all other appliances necessary or to be used in the constructing or operating or a telephone exchange or the maintenance thereof.

Section 2. The charges for the use of said telephones to the patrons shall not exceed \$18 for business houses, nor \$12 for residences annually.

Section 3. Said C. R. Eaton successors and assigns shall hold the city harmless for all damage arising from the granting of this ordinance or from the construction and maintenance or the exchange.

Section 4. Said C. R. Eaton, successors and assigns, agrees to have work commenced on said exchange not later than 60 days from the passage hereof and to have the exchange in operation not later than 120 days from same date.

Section 5. Said C. R. Eaton, successors and assigns, shall file acceptance of this franchise with the city clerk within 15 days from the passage hereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in force and effect after its publication once in the official city paper.
