

ORDINANCE NO. 338

REPEALING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 304, AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN STREETS IN AND NEAR SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONES IN THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of controlling traffic to provide safety for school children during the time school buses are loading between the hours of 3:30 p.m. and 3:50 p.m. on days in which school is in session. Fourth Street from Sedgwick Avenue to the Alley running north and south in Block 2, Henry Astle's First Addition, shall be closed to vehicular traffic.

Sections 2, 3, and 4 shall remain the same.
