**ORDINANCE NO. 349**

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE GROWTH OF WEEDS AND OBNOXIOUS GROWTHS OF VEGETATION ON LOTS OR PIECES OF LAND WITHIN THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The rank growth of weeds and obnoxious growths of vegetation are hereby declared to be a nuisance, and it shall be unlawful for any occupant, owner or person in charge of lots or pieces of land within the City to fail to cut and destroy all such weeds and vegetation on such lots or pieces of land and in the streets and alleys in front of and abutting upon such lots or pieces of land occupied or owned by them or under their charge, within fourteen (14) days after having been notified to do so in writing by the Clerk of the City of Haven, Kansas.

SECTION 2. That any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and in the case of the failure, neglect or refusal of the owner, occupant or person in charge of such lots or pieces of land within the corporate limits of the City of Haven, Kansas, to cut and destroy said growth of weeds and/or obnoxious growths of vegetations as aforesaid, a warrant shall be issued for such person's arrest. Any person convicted of a violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined in any sum not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its official approval, passage and publication once in the official city paper.
