AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CURFEW REGULATIONS AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS,

Section One: Curfew-Children. It shall be unlawful for any child under the age of sixteen (16) years to wander, lounge, loaf, loiter or play in, about or upon any public street alley, sidewalk, vacant lot, parking lot, park, playground, public place or other place normally accessible to the general public for public use, whether on foot or in a vehicle or by any other means after the hour of 11:00 o'clock P.M. before the hour of 6:00 o'clock A.M. and it further shall be unlawful for any child under the age of eighteen (18) years to wander, lounge, loaf, loiter, or play in about or upon any public street, alley, sidewalk, vacant lot, park, playground,, public place or other place normally accessible to the public for public use, whether on foot or in a vehicle or by other means after the hour of 12:00 o'clock midnight and before the hour of 6:00 o'clock A.M.; Provided, However, that such prohibition shall not apply to those children who are accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, nor to those who are enroute by the most direct and accessible route from an authorized place of employment, authorized place of entertainment, or authorized place of attendance to their residences; Provided, Further, that the term "authorized" as used in this section shall denote prior authorization by a parent or legal guardian.

Section Two: That any persons convicted of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined an amount not less than \$10.00 or more than \$100.00.

Section Three: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication once in the official city newspaper.
