

ORDINANCE NO. 360

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CERTAIN CONDUCT BY PARENTS AND LEGAL GUARDIANS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS.

Section One: Parents and Others. It shall be unlawful for any parent or legal guardian of any child under the age of eighteen (18) years to suffer, permit or allow such child to wander, lounge, loaf, loiter or play in, about or upon any public street, alley, sidewalk, vacant lot, parking lot, park, playground, public place or other place normally accessible to the general public for public use, during the hours of curfew applicable to such child in violation of Ordinance No. 359.

Section Two: That any persons convicted of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined an amount not less than \$10.00 not more than \$100.00.

Section Three: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication once in the official city newspaper.
