

ORDINANCE NO. 387

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HAVEN, AND CHANGING SPEED LIMITS IN CERTAIN AREAS OF THE CITY.

SECTION 1. When signs are erected giving notice thereof no person shall at any time school is in session park a vehicle on the east and west sides of Emporia Street from Sedgwick Place to Sunset Lane.

SECTION 2. Extending speed limit on Kansas Avenue. The governing body, having determined on the basis of a traffic study that the present speed limit of 30 miles per hour is unsafe. A speed limit of twenty (20) miles per hour to be effective when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected upon South Kansas Avenue from Second Street to 96 Highway.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the Haven Journal, the official newspaper of said city.
