

ORDINANCE NO. 395

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO J TURNS. DESCRIBING, DEFINING AND PROVIDING FOR THE PENALTIES THEREOF. PROVIDING FOR U TURNS AT KANSAS AVENUE AND SECOND STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. J TURNS UNLAWFUL. It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to make a J Turn on Kansas Avenue between Highway 96 and one-half block north of Main on Kansas Avenue, an area commonly known as the central business district, except at the intersection of two or more public streets, and private roads or driveways for the purpose of entering onto private property.

SECTION 2. J TURNS DEFINED. A J Turn for the purpose of this Ordinance shall be defined as a turning movement to the left across the flow, or potential flow, of oncoming traffic.

SECTION 3. U TURNS. It shall be lawful to make a U Turn at the intersection of Kansas Avenue and Second Street.

SECTION 4. U TURNS. It shall be unlawful to make a U Turn at the intersection of Kansas Avenue and Main Street and the intersection of Kansas Avenue and First Street because of the posted four-way-stop signs.

SECTION 5. PENALTY. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 6. THAT THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication once in the official newspaper.
