

ORDINANCE NO. 420

AN ORDINANCE REVOKING ORDINANCE NO. 402 PASSED BY THE GOVERNING BODY ON THE 7TH DAY OF MAY, 1979, AND AMENDING SECTION 33 OF ORDINANCE 371, PASSED AND APPROVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY ON OCTOBER 4, 1976, REGULATING THE SPEED OF VEHICLES DRIVEN ON THE BUHLER-HAVEN ROAD WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF HAVEN, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 402 passed and approved by the Governing Body the 7th day of May, 1979, is hereby revoked and hold for not.

SECTION 2: That the City Council has determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that a reasonable maximum speed for the Buhler-Haven Road, which establishes the Eastern boundary of the corporate limits from First Street North to Fifth Street is 35 mph.

SECTION 3: That Section 33 of Ordinance No. 371 passed and approved by the Governing Body on October 4, 1976 is hereby amended by the addition of sub-paragraph A-5 which will read as follows:

No person shall drive a vehicle in any speed in excess of 35 mph on that thoroughfare within the city limits of the City of Haven, Kansas known as the Buhler-Haven Road which establishes the Eastern boundary of the corporate limits from First Street North to Fifth Street.

SECTION 4: The Chief of Police is authorized to post said thoroughfare with speed limit signs indicating the authorized speed limit.

SECTION 5: That all the provisions, sections and paragraphs of Ordinance No. 371 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication once in the official city newspaper.
