

ORDINANCE NO. 423

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE HARBORING OF ANIMALS, DOMESTICATED OR NON-DOMESTICATED, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HAVEN, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Any person who shall keep harbor, board or maintain horses, cattle hogs, fowl or other animals, domesticated or non-domesticated, excluding vaccinated and lawfully licensed domesticated dogs and or cats, within the corporate limits of the City of Haven, Kansas shall upon conviction, be guilty of maintaining a public nuisance, endangering the public health, safety, and or welfare of the residents of the City of Haven, Kansas.

Further, that the provisions of this Section 1 shall not apply to a licensed Doctor of Veterinary Medicine engaged in his profession.

SECTION 2. PENALTIES: Violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each such violation; and if said public nuisance be not removed within seven (7) days thereafter, same shall be deemed a second violation subject to an additional fine as provided herein, and further, each succeeding seven (7) days thereafter shall be considered still an additional violation against the provisions of this Ordinance and be subject to an additional fine as provided herein.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from, and after, its publication in the official city newspaper, The Haven Journal.
