

ORDINANCE NO. 44

An ordinance relating to weeds.

Be it ordained by the mayor and council of the city of Haven.

Section 1. That the owners or occupants of any lots or tract of land located within the limits of the city of Haven shall keep the brick or cement sidewalks abutting on said lots or tract of land; clean and clear of grass and weeds.

Section 2. The owner or occupants of any lot or tract of land within the limits of the city of Haven shall keep the same reasonably free from weeds, and it is hereby provided that one-half of the alley and three feet outside of the line of street trees, abutting said lots and tract of land, shall be considered as parts of same.

Section 3. If after notification by the mayor or acting marshal, any person shall neglect to cut and clear away the grass or weeds as specified in sections one and two of this ordinance, then shall the mayor or the street commissioner of said city of Haven, empowered to order such work performed and to charge the cost of same, together with an equal amount as penalty, against said lots or tract of land and instruct the county clerk to collect same as taxes according to law.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its publication in the Haven Journal.
