## ORDINANCE NO. 51

An ordinance relating to the obstructing of streets, alleys, and sidewalks.

Be it ordained by the mayor and council of the city of Haven, Kansas.

Section 1. That any person or persons who shall willfully or maliciously obstruct any street, alley or sidewalk within the limits of this city shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not exceeding one hundred (100.00) dollars.

Section 2. That any person or persons who shall drive across any sidewalk or approach to any street or alley crossing within the limits of this city, any team, single or double, of whatsoever kind, shall be deemed of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not exceeding twenty (\$20.00) dollars. It is provided, however, that crossings subject to the approval of the street committee of said city council may be maintained across said sidewalks for private use only, and any person or persons using said private crossings as a public highway shall be deemed guilty under this section of this ordinance.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in force from its publication in the Haven Journal.
