

ORDINANCE NO. 58

An ordinance relating to hay, straw, and fodder stacks.

Be it ordained by the mayor and councilmen of the city of Haven, Kansas.

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to stack or pile any hay, straw, or fodder of whatsoever kind upon any lot, alley, or street within the following named blocks within the city limits. Blocks numbered 12 and 13 and the east half of 14 and 17 and all of the blocks numbered 18, 19, 20, and 22, all of the original town of Haven, also the whole of block numbered 2 in the Haven Town Company's first addition to said town of Haven.

Section 2. Any person or persons who shall violate Section 1 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five (\$25.) dollars and costs of the suit.

Section 3. Nothing in this ordinance shall prevent any person or persons from storing hay, straw, or fodder in a suitable building, subject to the approval of the street committee of the council of the city of Haven.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be force and effect from and after its publication.
