

ORDINANCE NO. 65

An ordinance relating to hitching or tying horses or other animals on Kansas Avenue and prohibiting hitching posts and racks.

Be it ordained by the mayor and the councilmen of the city of Haven, Kansas.

Section 1. That ordinance no. 41 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person to construct or erect any hitching racks posts or hitching rings or otherwise construct any means of hitching or tying horses or other animals on Kansas Avenue or sidewalk abutting thereon between the railroad crossings south of second street and the alley running east and west between main and fourth streets.

Section 3. That it shall be unlawful for any person to hitch or tie any horse or other animal to any tree, awing post, telephone pole, or otherwise tie such animal or animals on Kansas Avenue between the limits named in section 2 of this ordinance.

Section 4. That all hitch racks, posts or other means of tying horses or other animals now erected on Kansas Avenue between the limits named in section 2 of this ordinance shall be removed by the owner as soon as this ordinance becomes effective; or otherwise they will be removed by the city at the owner's expense.

Section 5. That any person violating section 2 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in the sum of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty five dollars for each day such hitching racks, posts, or hitching rings are maintained.

Section 6. That any person violating section three of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in the sum of not less than five dollars nor more than fifteen dollars for each offense.

Section 7. That this ordinance shall be in effect on and after its publication in the Haven Journal.
