

ORDINANCE NO. 68

Be it ordained by the mayor and the councilmen of the city of Haven, Kansas.

Section 1. That the license for any circus, menagerie, or circus and menagerie combined, theatrical, minstrel or other troupe or company, the exhibition of which is to be held in a tent, pavilion or other enclosure, shall be five dollars (\$5.) per day when such troupe or company is composed of less than twenty-five (25) people and when composed of twenty-five (25) or more people the license shall be ten Dollars (\$10) per day.

Section 2. That when any show, entertainment or performance is given within the limits of the city of Haven for the purpose of aiding any charitable, religious or public enterprise, no license shall be charged.

Section 3. That the license set forth in section one of this ordinance shall be paid to the city clerk before the performance of each day begins.

Section 4. That ordinance number II be hereby repealed.

Section 5. That this ordinance be in force and effect on and after its publication in the Haven Journal.
