ORDINANCE NO. 79

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CONSTRUCTING AND INSPECTING CHIMNEYS

Be it ordained by the mayor and the councilmen of the city of Haven, Kansas.

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person firm or corporation to build a fire in any building within the limits of the city of Haven, Kansas, without first providing a safe chimney of brick or concrete for the passage of smoke from fire; all chimneys to extend at least three and one half feet above roof and shall be made safe in every respect.

Section 2. That the Street and Alley Committee shall as soon as this ordinance becomes effective, inspect or cause to be inspected all buildings within the limits of the Haven, Kansas, and shall make an inspection during September of each year thereafter. Said Street and Alley Committee shall have the power to order new chimneys built and chimneys repaired.

Section 3. That all property owners shall allow the inspection of any of their buildings in said city, by the Street and Alley Committee or any one duly authorized by said committee.

Section 4. That any person, firm or corporation violating section one of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in the sum of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$5.00 for each day that each building is without a chimney or with a defective chimney.

Section 5. That any one violating the third section of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be (fined) in the sum of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$10.00 for each offense.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall become effective on and after its publication in the Haven Journal.
